Dear Parents/Guardians,

The **Leaving and Junior Certificate Examinations begin on Wednesday June 5th, 2019.**

We would advise you to pay particular attention to your son/daughter's range of subjects for examination and the times and dates involved, as you may need to make alternative travel arrangements to and from school for the duration of the examinations.

Students are asked to be present at school **40 minutes prior to their exams.** It is school policy that all students **remain in the examination centre for the full duration of each examination,** in order to give each student every opportunity to do as well as they possibly can. **Should a student need to leave an examination early, a parent/guardian will be informed.** If a student is unavoidably late, the school office must be notified immediately, so we can notify the State Examinations Commission. Likewise, if an illness occurs, notification must be made so alternative exam arrangements can be organised if necessary.

Full school uniforms are to be worn for each exam. If there are any issues with uniforms, please contact the school before Tuesday 4th June.

The Canteen will be available for the first three days of the exams. **If students would like to pre-order lunch each morning before exams please notify office of their intention to do so by Tuesday 4th June in order for Canteen to place food order (you can leave a message on the office phone)**

Textbooks will be collected on the day of each exam. All books must be returned.
