What is safeTALK?

safeTALK is a 3.5 hour training programme that prepares participants over the age of 18 to identify people with thoughts of suicide and connect them to help.

safeTALK prepares participants to be a helper to someone thinking about suicide. Most people with thoughts of suicide invite help and want to stay alive.

safeTALK training prepares participants to help by using the steps of **TALK** (<u>Tell, Ask, Listen and Keep safe</u>) to identify people who are thinking about suicide and connect them with further help and care.
