Online School

- Homework Journal- use for recording homework/class assignments
 - Timetable- follow school timetable each day. – parents/guardians can access timetable on VSware app
 - Live Class Times – teachers set classes and it should be easy to join using the calendar
1. Check calendar
 2. Check class team
 3. Click join
 4. Message teacher if you cannot access the lesson.
 - Students are asked to attend live classes- teachers are continuing with the curriculum/classwork and you must make every effort to remain up to speed with your work.
 - Homework and assignments to be submitted on time.
 - Be prepared for class with correct books/books/another additional stationary, etc.
 - Roll call is taken every day – data logged on school system.
 - Absences – parents/guardians to contact school using email, email details on LHS of this document.
 - Participation and Engagement –reports will be released to parents/guardians next week to track students' online participation.
 - Devices- 50 laptops scanned out to families, please contact us if we can help include your email.
 - Mobile Data- for your information you can access unlimited data with your mobile provider.
 - Student Support- please see contact details for relevant school personnel
 - Password reset- please email your son/daughter's Student Director.




We as a school community will continue to support parents and students with Online learning.
